Making the District of Blaby and the Borough of Hinckley and Bosworth a safer place to live, work and visit

The Community Safety Partnership brings together statutory and non-statutory organisations and groups that have a positive impact on reducing crime, the fear of crime and work closely alongside local communities in bringing a sense of safety for all.

Everyone has the right to feel safe as they go about their daily lives and this can be achieved by all of us playing our part in tackling issues of crime and disorder.

Whilst Community Safety remains a top priority the resources to deliver safer communities faces some significant challenges that all aspects of the public sector are facing at the present time. To meet the challenges, the Community Safety Partnerships in the Blaby District and the Borough of Hinckley & Bosworth have joined together to share their expertise to help deliver effective and efficient community safety services across both areas.



The partnership has developed a three year strategic plan for 2011 to 2014 and this is the first year of that plan. We have built on previous successes and set some new challenges for the next 12 months with regard to local priorities.

Community Safety Priorities:

Our priorities are based upon information about crime and disorder issues across the district and borough and take into account the things local people consider to be of most concern.

The partnership has identified the following strategic priorities for the next 3 years:

- Improving Community Confidence, Engagement and Cohesion
- Identifying, Supporting and Protecting Vulnerable People
- Reducing Offending and Re-Offending.

Cross Cutting Theme:

- Reduction in harm caused by substance misuse.

Local Priorities:

Local people were consulted and said that our top 3 local priorities for the next year should be:

- Burglary
- Anti-social behaviour
- Vehicle crime (including speeding vehicles).

The partnership will work actively in specific locations, target known offenders and work with local people to ensure confidence and satisfaction with the way we deal with crime.
