Who can register to vote?

Anyone aged 16 & 17 or over (but you cannot vote until you are 18)

British or Commonwealth citizens.

Citizens of the Republic of Ireland or other European Union (EU) countries.

Citizens of EU countries (other than the UK, Ireland, Cyprus, Malta) cannot vote in UK Parliamentary elections.

What is the electoral register?

The electoral register is a list of everyone who is registered to vote. There are two versions - the full register and the edited register. You are **not** automatically registered; even if you pay Council Tax. You can register to vote at any time. If you're not registered, for example, if you have moved home, you need to complete this form.

Who has my personal details?

There are two versions of the register – the **full** version and the **edited** version. Your details will appear on the full version of the register, but you can **choose** whether or not your details appear on the edited register.

The full register is used for elections and referendums, preventing and detecting crime and checking applications for credit. The edited register is available for general sale and can be used for commercial activities such as marketing.

When will my application be added to the electoral register?

If your application is valid and not subject to any objections, we will change your details within 2 to 6 weeks of receiving your form. We will write to tell you when you will be added to the electoral register. If you return this form by the dates shown below we will endeavour to add you to the next available register.

There is no monthly update during September, October or November during the annual canvass period when all households have to register. A new Register is published on 1 December.	

We will also tell the Electoral Registration Officer for your old address that you have moved so that your name can be removed from that register. People who live at two homes (including students) are allowed to register at both. If you do not want to be removed from your other address please state this on your form.

There are special rules about names being added to the voters list during an election period. Because of these you may not be able to vote at that election if you are added during this time.
