

APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE LICENSING ACT 2003

NOTICE is hereby given that the Licensing Authority of Blaby District Council has on 31st October 2011 received an application for the review of the premises licence in respect of the premises known as

The grounds for the review application are:

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is level 5 on the standard scale, currently £5,000.
