Our overall aim is to maximise the independence of vulnerable people. Blaby District Council works closely with partners to ensure services are customer-focused, accessible and effective. The Housing and Community Services Group is focused on understanding and liaising with vulnerable and hard to reach groups, including*:

- People who have been homeless or rough sleepers
- Ex-offenders and people at risk of offending and imprisonment
- People with a physical or sensory disability
- People at risk of domestic violence
- People with alcohol and drug problems
- Teenage parents
- Elderly people
- Young people at risk
- People with HIV and AIDS
- People with learning difficulties
- Travellers
- Homeless families with support needs
