

How to make representations on the Core Strategy (submission version) – Representations procedure.

Consultation on the Core Strategy (submission version) is for a 6 week period starting on 30th July. Any representations must be received no later than **Thursday 10th September 2009**. The Council may not be able to consider representations received after this date because they may not be 'duly made'.

Responses can be made by the following means:

1) Electronically by using the link available on the Council's web-site **www.blaby.gov.uk**

The Council **STRONGLY ENCOURAGES** the submission of comments using the electronic form available on the Council's web-site. This method of submission speeds up the process and is more sustainable because it does not use paper – it is also free.

Any comments made on the Core Strategy (submission version) will be sent to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government and considered as part of the Examination of the Core Strategy. It is anticipated that the 'hearing sessions' of the Examination will take place in the spring of 2010.
